In this assignment, students will complete one oral interview assignment and 2 other mini-assignments related to lifestyles in Newfoundland and Labrador. All students must complete the interview and then any two other squares. This is an individual project. See the back for specifications for each option. Total: 45 marks.

MUST COMPLETE

Conduct an interview with someone over the age of 40 regarding what their school days were like. No "Yes/No" answers and a minimum of 10 questions. Record your questions and answers as a typed assignment (25)

Allergy alert –no nuts/kiwi /mango</p> <p>(10)</p>	<p>Model Option</p> <p>Using popsicle sticks or other material, construct a model of a tilt, saltbox or square-roof house.</p> <p>(10)</p>	<p>Home Remedies Option</p> <p>Do a bristol board display/powerpoint or Google slideshow on 5 traditional NL home remedies for health problems. You must include text and pictures.</p> <p>(10)</p>
<p>Traditional Meal Option</p> <p>Prepare a traditional NL/Lab meal for your family. Take video or take pictures and place them on bristol board or in a Google slideshow to show to the class. List the ingredients</p> <p>(10)</p>	<p>Recipe Collection - Crossed with Home Ec.</p> <p>Compile a collection of easy to use, favourite Newfoundland recipes (10 in total). Each recipe should include the ingredients as well as the complete step by step directions. Have at <u>least 2 examples of each of the following:</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Cookie Dessert / Cake Main course Breakfast item (Muffin, pancakes, Jam, etc..) healthy version meal using a Newfoundland ingredient. (10) 	<p>Games Option</p> <p>Find out the rules of a traditional NL game (such as rounders, piddly, cricket) and do a Powerpoint/Google Slides or poster on how the game is played. Include the rules, who would play, how many team members etc. (10)</p>

Specifications for the Project (Rubric)

Traditional Dessert (10 marks)

The project must include :

1. The dessert. (5) You do not need to make enough for everyone.
2. The recipe must include the following: (2)
 - a. Title of food item
 - b. List of Ingredients
 - c. Step by step instructions
3. Three pictures showing the following (3)
 - a. Ingredients all laid out (group shot is okay)
 - b. The process of making the item (you should be in at least one picture)
 - c. A picture of your finished food item/product

House model (10 marks)

The model must have :

1. windows and doors (1)
2. roofing/shingles (1)
3. A chimney (1)
4. Aesthetics (colour, construction) (5).
5. Be a minimum of 10 cm X10 cm X10 cm (2)

Traditional meal (10 marks)

The traditional meal must include :

1. At least 5 pictures of you preparing and eating the dish (5)
2. Include a list of the ingredients (3)
3. Traditional meal (2)

Recipe Collection (10 marks)

1. DECORATIVE cover for your recipe collection. (Does NOT have to be hand-drawn, but should have a Stylized Title, including a picture, and indicate yourself as the author of the collection. (2)
2. All Headings / font style/ sizing / etc..for all recipes is consistent in the entire collection. (1)
3. A total of 10 recipes (as indicated above). Each recipe must contain a list of ingredients as well as step-by-step directions. (6)
4. The overall visual appeal of the collection. (Pictures and / or colour are not a requirement but would certainly add to the visual appeal of the overall collection. (1)

Games Option (10 marks)

The games option must have :

1. All the rules for playing the game including number of players, where played (5).
2. The equipment used (2)
3. At least 3 relevant pictures (3)

Home Remedies option (10 marks)

The home remedy option must have :

1. Five NL home remedies fully explained (5).
2. A picture for each home remedy (5)

Interview (25 marks)

The interview must:

1. 2 marks for fitting the interviewee requirements (Name and age) (2marks)
2. Organization - questions are numbered/spelling checked/stapled with title page (3 marks)
3. Questions - marks for each question (10 questions minimum/ responses have to be more than yes/no) (20)
